Guidelines Development of University Studies Courses (April 15, 2015)

General Policies:

- **1.** Prior to its initial offering, a new UNST course must be approved by the UNST Council and will be periodically evaluated.
- **2.** New instructors for existing UNST courses must also be approved by the UNST Council.
- 3. UNST theme courses should have a minimum of 8 students to be offered.
- **4.** UNST courses generally should not have pre-requisites. Upper division breadth courses may have pre-requisites, approved on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Subjects must be broad in nature and may not be reducible to a narrow or focused topic or skill.
- **6.** Generally, UNST theme courses are team-taught by faculty from two different disciplines.
