

Guidelines
Development of University Studies Courses
(April 15, 2015)

General Policies:

1. Prior to its initial offering, a new UNST course must be approved by the UNST Council and will be periodically evaluated.
2. New instructors for existing UNST courses must also be approved by the UNST Council.
3. UNST theme courses should have a minimum of 8 students to be offered.
4. UNST courses generally should not have pre-requisites. Upper division breadth courses may have pre-requisites, approved on a case-by-case basis.
5. Subjects must be broad in nature and may not be reducible to a narrow or focused topic or skill.
6. Generally, UNST theme courses are team-taught by faculty from two different disciplines.
